

Languages Connect: An Erasmus Encounter in Luxembourg

The French class of Year 7 at Friedrichschule experienced first-hand just how lively and connecting multilingualism can be during an Erasmus third-location encounter in Luxembourg.

From Wednesday, 20 May, to Friday, 22 May 2026, the group travelled by train via Offenburg and Strasbourg to the multilingual Grand Duchy of Luxembourg, accompanied by Mr Moreschi and Ms Parzefall.

At the heart of the visit was the encounter with students from the Belgian school Le Verseau in Wavre. On Thursday, 21 May, both groups spent the day together in Luxembourg City. The young people had the opportunity to talk to one another, put their French and English skills into practice, and gain insights into the lives of students of the same age from another country.

Luxembourg provided an ideal setting for the encounter. As a multilingual country, it demonstrates in everyday life the opportunities and advantages that language skills can open up. During a range of activities in the historic city centre, including a language-themed city rally, the students explored Luxembourg together and used their foreign-language skills in a playful and authentic way.
